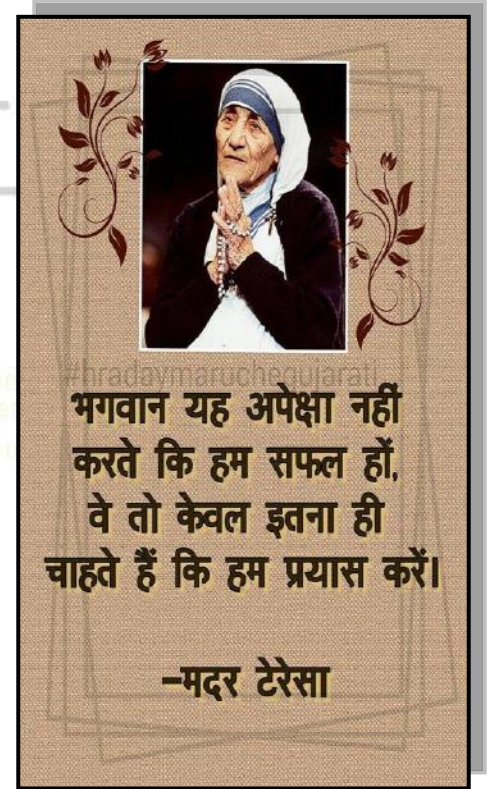

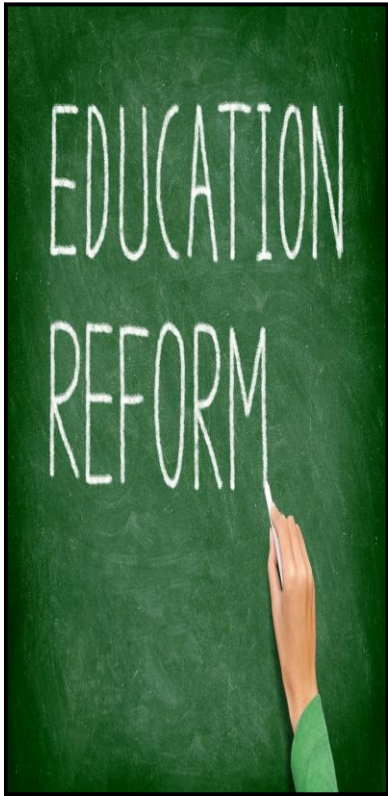

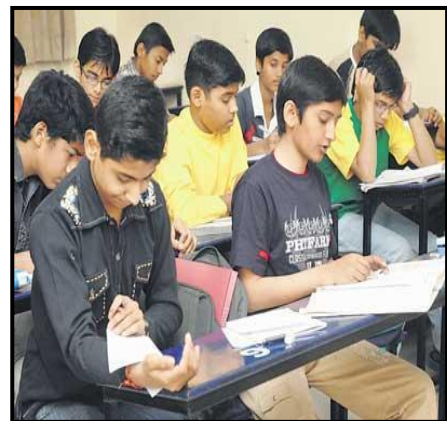

The adults pursuing higher secondary education are not able to enjoy the benefits of reservation scheme offered by government services.

### 2. Coaching Programme For SC/ST & OBC Students

A free coaching centre for ST, SC and OBC students is instituted by this organisation at Delhi since this year from its own sources. Initially this coaching provided teaching to students of Class Ist to Vth level, who are coming from the aforesaid categories with a poor status. More than 30 of such students are admitted during this year, and they are given support to cover their courses reading in their respective schools. Two numbers of teachers are engaged in this centre by the organisation till date and they are given lump-sum monitoring support from organisation sources. The organisation planned to extend this centre in coming period .we could distribute study materials to students also.





### 3. Free EVENT FACILITATOR Run By Ministry of Torisum

The organisation Free Awareness/Premotion of **EVENT FACILTATOR**. This course is conducted by Ashok Institute of Hospitality & Tourism Management and is run by the Ministry of Torisum . Its own sources in which 10 students are given admission in vocational traning programme and student get the following benefits:

- Free of Cost Courses
- Eligibility minimum 8<sup>th</sup> Passed
- Duration 6 Weeks
- Age 18 to 28
- Free Uniform Provided
- Free Tool Kit
- Free Lunch during courses
- Student with 90% attendance will be given stipend of Rs.1500/-

Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board (DUSIB) functions under the control of Govt. of NCT of Delhi and is primarily functioning under the purview of the DUSIB Act, 2010. This act empowers the DUSIB to notify certain areas as Slums, where with the passage of time, the buildings have become dilapidated and the basic civic services are missing. Apart from this, DUSIB has also been assigned the role of looking after the Jhuggie Jhomprie squatter settlements / clusters by way of provision of civic amenities and their resettlement too.

It has been more than 60 years after independence but the change has recently begun under the great supervision of Supreme Court of India. After a series of deaths of homeless people on Delhi streets in the winter of 2009 - 10, the highest court of our land stepped in to enforce the rights of these most marginalized people with a dignified life.

In order to make grievance redress a live mechanism, each shelter should maintain the following records:

The objectives of the programme are:

1. Create awareness among the participants about the magnitude of the problem, its modus operations and consequences; familiarize them about the Governmental initiatives to address the problem. Sensitize them about the rehabilitation and repatriation of women/ child survivors of trafficking and analyze the role of NGOs in prevention of trafficking of women and children.

- Special Focus on Child Victims. Rehabilitation, Reintegration and Repatriation of Trafficked Victims with Special Focus on Child Victims.
- Cross-Border Trafficking: National and Regional Cooperation and Coordination.
- Legal Framework and Law Enforcement
- Witness Protection and Support to Victims
- Training, Sensitization, Education and Awareness
- Methodology for Translating the Action Point into Action
