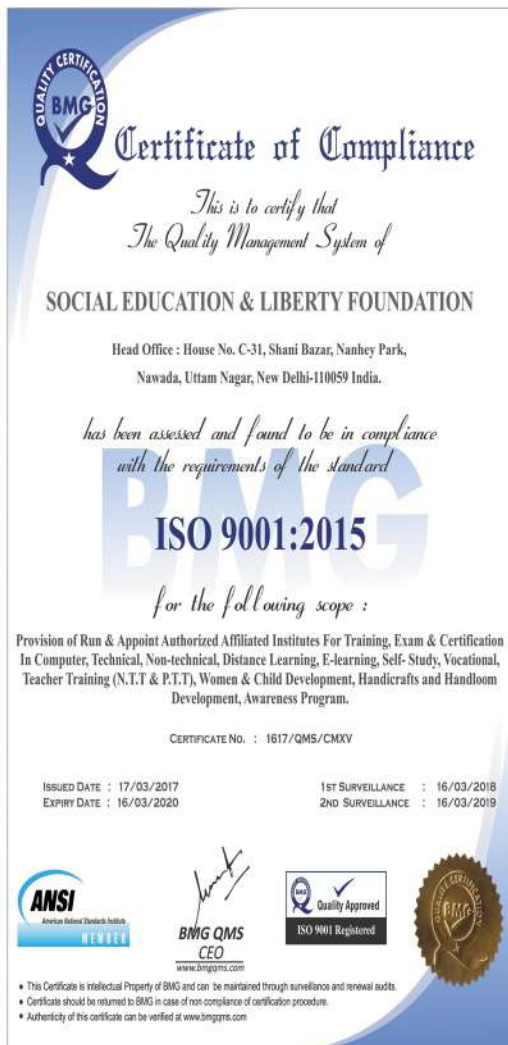

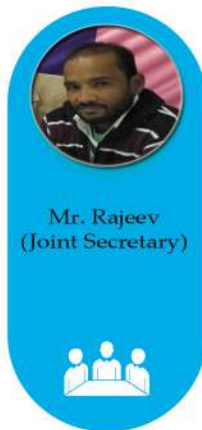

Subject: Orientation Programme for Mother NGOs of Health Ministry on Growth Monitoring and Usage of Mother and Child Protection Card from 4-6 May, 2016 at NIPCCD, New Delhi

### Objectives

The main objectives of the programme would be to:  
orient the functionaries of MNGOs/FNGOs to the New WHO Child Growth Standards and the joint MCP Card; and equip them with necessary skills to use new WHO growth chart, and joint MCP card in ICDS.

### Methodology for Approach

The contents of the orientation course will be covered through lecture-cum-discussion, group discussion, brainstorming, demonstration, and practical exercises with emphasis on participatory methods of learning. The course would be designed to facilitate sequential flow of learning, as also to provide opportunities to relate to real life situation, wherever possible.

Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MOHFW) and Ministry of Women and Child Development. The new WHO child growth standards, globally used, have unique features as they prescribe how children should grow – when her or his basic needs being met in a nurturing environment. They establish breastfed infants as the normative growth model and demonstrate for the first time ever, that children born in different regions of the world have the potential to grow and develop within the same range of height and weight for age if they are given the optimum start in life.

A dozen baseras became a canvas for the project. In all, the Capitalhas around 270 such sanctuaries, run by various NGOs, according to the Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board (Dusib), the nodal agency. Its website lists 92 shelters in “permanent buildings”, 112 in “porta cabins”, 55 in tents and five in unused buses. Each shelter has dhurries and blankets; water and toilet facilities; and caretakers. Some shelters are free; others charge a nominal amount. The latest figures available put night-time occupancy at around 6,000 people, though the total capacity is around 2000.

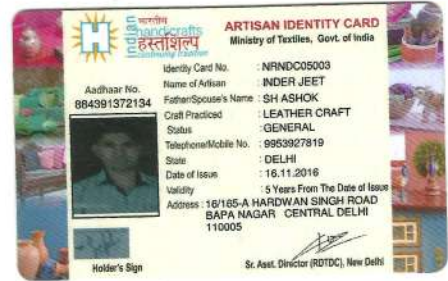

The demand for a law on domestic violence was made in the context of protecting married women and also women in the shared household such as mothers, sisters and women in relationships in the nature of marriage. The enactment of the Protection of Women form Domestic Violence Act (PWDVA) in 2005 is the most important initiative of the Indian government in this regards. The PWDVA,2005 is a civil law that defines domestic violence,recognizes a woman’s right to reside in a violence-free home and provides remedies in cases of violence at the hands of the husband or male live-in partner.



### Protection of Women against Domestic Violence Act (PWDVA) 2005: highlights
